Liege Airport, July 14, 2008

**Liege Airport sets up a shuttle service
from Antwerp, Brussels and Aachen**

Liege, July 14, 2008 – as revealed at the June 24 press conference, Liege Airport has launched a shuttle service to better serve the airport and its most frequently requested destinations.

“It is in order to meet the demands of German and Brussels passengers that Liege Airport has set up this shuttle service. As well as the two existing Antwerp-bound shuttles, two weekly return shuttles will be launched, serving Brussels and Aachen”, explained Luc Partoune.

These transfers will begin as of July 15, 2008 costing €15 per adult and €10 per child (≤ 12 years).

This initiative, implemented in partnership with Eurobussing, will allow the new destinations of Tel Aviv, Pristina and Tirana to be developed, leaving from Liege Airport and further destinations to be established.
